

EASTER BUMP GAME

Make 11 egg shapes on a piece of paper.



Place the numbers; 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12 inside each of the boxes.



You are now ready to play the game.

- You will need 2 dice or playing cards or make your own number cards.
 - If you have dice you are ready to play.
 - If you are using cards, you need all the, A's (1)2's, 3's,4's,5's,6's out of the deck of cards. Shuffle the cards and take 2 cards when it is your turn. Put cards under the deck when finished.
 - If you do not have dice or cards, cut square paper and make 4 of the numbers, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. Play the same way as cards.
- You will also need 11-20 pieces per player to cover up your numbers. These can be Lego pieces, Coins, Cereal, macaroni, or other items you have around the house.

To Play:

Each person rolls the dice or takes 2 cards. Add the numbers together.

Cover the number on the game board with your pieces.

The next person has a turn.

If another player rolls/draws the same number, they can bump and replace the piece with his/her own.

If you roll a number you already have you can put 2 pieces on the number and it locks it so the other players can not knock off your piece.

Play continues until all the numbers are covered.

Students have played this game lots in class and should be familiar with the rules.
