

At school we were working on how to plan a story and write it into parts. This Plan is broken up into 4 parts. The beginning, 2 middle events and the ending. Start by writing your story plan. Then use your plan to write your story. Here is my example:

My Story Plan:

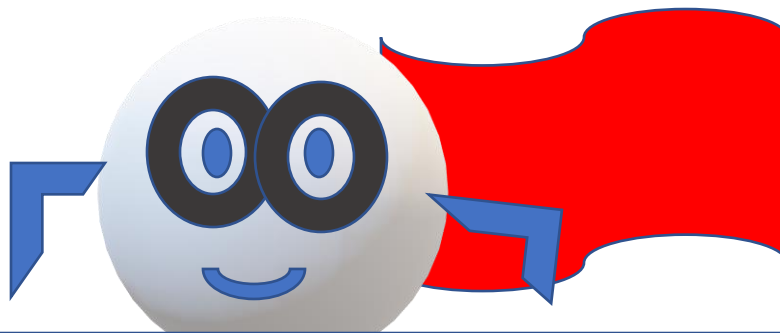
Character and setting: I am going to create a superhero sphere. He will live on the flat planet of boxy.

Problem: Everywhere he goes he is always rolling into things all over town.

First: He tries to put shoes on so he will not roll.

Next: He tries to hold onto the wall to help him.

Finally: He learns that rolling is a true superpower.



My Story:

One day on the planet of boxy, Superhero Sphere decided to go for a walk and see if any one needed saving. He rolled down the sidewalk and right off the curb. He was almost ran over by a cylinder riding a bike! Close call. Once he was back on the sidewalk he waved at cone and ran into the wall. Being round is sometimes hard. As he was rounding the corner he bumped into Cube and spilled his coffee all over. He decided he needed to do something about his clumsy rolling.

First, he decided to try to glue shoes on to him. He went to his house and grabbed glue, tape, and his brother's shoes. He glued and taped the shoes onto the bottom of his body. Then he tried to go outside. He could not roll! When he went to move, it felt like he was rolling over giant speed bumps. He decided shoes would not work so he took them off.

Next, Super Sphere decides he will only go around town if he can hold onto the side of a wall. He heads out to visit his friends. On the way he rolls from house to house holding onto the walls. Then he must cross the street. There are no walls. He decides to head home and think of another way.

When he gets home, he calls his friends cube and cone. They come over and help with a plan. They are all sitting in his back yard, when they hear a loud "meow!" coming from the tree. A cat is stuck in the tree. Cube tries to rescue it but can not move up the tree. Cone tries to rescue it, but the cat is too afraid of the point of his head. Finally, Super Sphere takes a running roll and rolls up the tree. The cat jumps on him. Super sphere brings him down the tree.

Super sphere realizes that being a sphere is o.k. Everyone is unique and has special talents.
